Sheffield is one of the UK's biggest cities, and Sheffield Hallam sits right at the heart of the city centre.

We've invested more than £100 million in new facilities over the last five years, including 24-hour libraries, student-designed study areas, and the same equipment you'll find in your future workplace, whether that's an aeroplane manufacturer or a hospital.

Over the next five years we'll be investing a further £220m in our campuses. We'll be developing completely new buildings for Sheffield Business School and the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities. We'll also be creating landscaped green spaces and refurbishing many of our existing facilities, including the Students' Union building.

Library Facilities

There are two libraries, one on each campus (City and Collegiate Crescent). They provide access to:

- Library and media resources
- PCs and printing
- A range of study spaces
- A range of specialist equipment (ATR) for students registered with the Disabled Student Support Team
- Areas to eat and drink
- Library and IT help and support you can use for your course work

Skills Centre

The Skills Centre offers workshops, small group forums and drop-ins for all students to help you develop your academic skills throughout your studies. Example themes include:

- Assignment planning
- Critical writing
- Presentation skills
- Research planning

Student Advice Centre

SHU Card

Go cashless with your SHU Card. It's the most convenient way to pay for goods and services on campus. You'll also be eligible for an NUS card, enabling you to get discounts on travel, eating out and shopping.

Student Wellbeing

Three dedicated advisers

As an apprentice you'll have three advisers looking out for you during your course.

- 1. **Academic Mentor** one of the faculty staff from SHU who will support your academic journey and performance during the time you spend at University.
- 2. **Work-based Learning Coach** part of the SHU apprenticeships team who will visit you at your job and ensure that you are keeping on track with the required capabilities and documentation.
- 3. **Workplace Mentor** a member of staff from the company you work for who will provide help and guidance at your place of work, making sure that you achieve your goals.
