

What is School Direct?

School Direct is an exciting new route into teaching leading to Qualified Teacher Status and a PGCE. It allows you to choose the school, or partnership of schools that you will be trained in, and this will be further supported by training from Sheffield Hallam. The intention is that you will be employed to teach in the school or another school in the partnership upon successful completion of the PGCE.

The qualification can be used as the first third of a masters degree if you wish to continue with this accredited professional development in the early part of your career.

How does this differ to other PGCE routes at Sheffield Hallam?

- You choose and apply to a school, or partnership of schools, to carry out your training.
- All your school-based learning takes place with that school, or with other schools in that partnership. (On an existing PGCE route, you still complete school-based learning, but the schools are selected by us from the 400 schools in our placement network.)
- The school or partnership of schools that you have applied to is much more involved in your selection, recruitment and professional development as there is the expectation that you will be employed by them once qualified.

What does the training involve?

As part of the training you

- are supported by outstanding teachers, have a school-based mentor and an academic tutor from the University – all dedicated to your development as a high-quality, reflective practitioner
- benefit from sessions with other PGCE students at the University where research- informed practice and a theoretical underpinning of classroom practice is shared and critiqued
- are on a new route, but one which is carefully co-planned between schools involved and the University and builds upon excellent practice already established in the partnership
