Art Therapy Placement Allocation Process – Description

- 1. Education Audit confirms available placements for year.
- 2. List of providers given to students.
- 3. The student completes a **Placement Consideration Form** prioritising an interest in placements with **Adults**, or **Children and Young People**, or **Both**

Care needs or other additional needs indicated and submitted to the placement team.

- 4. Priority is based on geographical location followed by additional needs, followed by above preferences, and allocated at random.
- 5. Names of trainees sent to Placement Supervisors.
- 6. Allocation of placements individually emailed to students.
- 7. Student is required to contact the Placement Supervisor 2 weeks prior to commencement of placement to introduce themselves and to agree:
 - Placement day pattern
 - Start date and time
 - Date and time for first supervision
