Art Therapy Placement Allocation Process – Description

1. Education Audit – confirms available placements for year.
2. List of providers given to students.
3. The student completes a **Placement Consideration Form** prioritising an interest in placements with **Adults**, or **Children and Young People**, or **Both**

Care needs or other additional needs indicated and submitted to the placement team.

4. Priority is based on geographical location followed by additional needs, followed by above preferences, and allocated at random.
5. Names of trainees sent to Placement Supervisors.
6. Allocation of placements individually emailed to students.
7. Student is required to contact the Placement Supervisor 2 weeks prior to commencement of placement to introduce themselves and to agree:
 - **Placement day pattern**
 - **Start date and time**
 - **Date and time for first supervision**
