We are a Children's Centre working across three sites and a large geographic area - Swinton, Wath and Brampton. So being able to drive and access to a vehicle is essential.

We primarily support children from pre-birth to 5. However, we do now work with families with children up to 19 years old, 25 with disabilities. It is important to be confident in speaking to parents, rather than just working with children.

- Shadowing breast feeding supporters
- Outreach activities such as door knocking to promote 2 year funding for childcare
- Pre-birth and new birth home visits

- Family support home visits
- Completion of Early Help Assessments
- Child's voice work Team around the family meetings
- Possible CIN, CP meetings and conferences (social care)

- Attend advisory board
