

# Our Expectation of Radiography Students

## Be Prepared

Be prepared for placement; complete recommended pre-reading and any designated tasks as required. Set weekly goals have a pro-active approach towards placement to gain the best experience!



## Raise Concerns

Raise concerns or queries promptly – we are here to help you! You can speak to your Supervisor, Student Liaisons, Site lead, Clinical Link Tutor, Personal Tutor and Practice Placement Manager. Alternatively if you would rather speak up anonymously, there are freedom to speak up Guardian's you can speak to or you can utilise the student surveys.



## Scope of Practice

Make supervisors aware of your scope of practice and individual learning style, discuss and escalate if supervisors expectations exceed your level of study.



## Constructive Feedback

Expect and be receptive to constructive feedback; this helps you learn. Take time to reflect on feedback and use it to improve your future practice. Be proactive with your learning and engage in CPD sessions and weekly student drop in sessions.



## Respect

Be respectful and considerate of ALL staff within the multidisciplinary team, understanding that they must prioritise safe service delivery around education. Maintain professional boundaries. Be kind, considerate and respect all individual backgrounds and needs.



## Time Keeping and Absent Reporting

Be punctual and in your placement area ready to engage at your start time. Time keeping is your responsibility. In the eventuality of unanticipated delays, please inform your area and the Practice Placement Manager. You must sign using the student registers prior to every shift and sign out at the end of the day. We expect 100% attendance for the duration of your placement, however, if you are unwell, you must not attend placement. It is your responsibility to contact the placement area and PPM in line with absent reporting policy.



## Uniform

You must be presentable with clean uniform, your TLD and must be bare below the elbow in clinical areas. You are a representative of the Trust, your university, and your department alike; your appearance must reflect this by adhering to uniform policy.



## Policies and Procedures

Ensure you are abiding by and following procedures and policies, both Trust and local to your placement area. Comply with professional body and HCPC standards and regulations.
