

# Our Expectation of Radiography Student Supervisors

#### Raise Student Concerns

Challenge inappropriate behaviour and escalate any concerns immediately with Practice Placement Manager, Student Liaisons, Education Team or University Link Tutor.



#### Give Constructive Feedback

Understand and appreciate that students are all individual learners and will all learn differently to each other. Take the time to understand your students and their learning styles to best support them. Give regular constructive feedback and document this within their clinical placement books.



#### Student Allocation

Ensure students are working within their allocated areas, according to the rota. If you are due to have a student and they are absent, escalate this to the Practice Placement Manager. Allocate Students a supervisor for the day and support them with their weekly objectives.



#### Document

Document any feedback, action plans, concerns, praises, assessment passes/failures within the students clinical placement books.



### **Training and Support**

If you don't feel equipped to support students, ask for the necessary support or training from your line managers and the Practice and Education team to enable you to do so. Utilise the practice placement manager and seek support when you need help.



### Respect

Be respectful and appreciate that students are a valuable member of the team and our future workforce. Be kind, considerate and respect individual needs; maintain professional boundaries.



### **Enagage and Motivate**

Ask your students what their objectives are for the week and how you can support them. Ensure students are also given positive feedback to know what they are doing well! Let the PPM know about student praise too; let's celebrate our students.



## Supervise and Teach

We expect all radiographers to teach and supervise students with appropriately delegated tasks. You must be able to justify the level of supervision you provide. Ensure you fully understand the programme of students and the expectation of their HEI. Provide students with the necessary resources and standards of practice
