What is a Degree Apprenticeship?

- Government driven
- Combining Part-time learning (minimum of 20%) with Part-time working
- Supported by workplace by using apprenticeship levy
- Learning carries over into work

Teaching at SHU

- NO long breaks within the programme (52 week year)
- 36 month course overall, 36 months of delivery
- Block delivery:
 - Teaching blocks, includes Integrated Care Curriculum like BSc programme
 - Placement where work-based tasks are completed
- Mainly online/distance learning with some on campus touch points

Work-based Mentor and Work-based Learning Coach

- Each apprentice has a mentor (approx 30 hours) in the workplace
 - Support the learner
 - Implement learning in the workplace within contract
 - Takes part in progress reviews
- Each apprentices has a work-based learning coach through the university
 - Facilitates progress reviews
 - Monitors progress
 - Closely links with academic advisor and course team
- Students create a portfolio throughout their course to evidence learning and progression. This is mapped to the <u>degree apprenticeship standards</u>.

Placement guidance

- Apprentices are entitled to a day a week of study time/OTJL
- Apprentices do not receive a SHU student uniform
- Apprentices require immunisations and completion of mandatory training for clearance prior to starting placement
- They should aim to complete normal (contracted) working hours whilst on placement.
- Absence reporting follows the Trust procedures.

DA Clinical Assessment flowchart

- Clinical competency is assessed during each of the 3 years of the course:
- The Practice Placement modules ensure the apprentice is documenting and steering their own learning and development in relation to the KSBs by producing an e-portfolio.
- The Competence for Practice modules are assessed by mentors in clinical practice.
