What is the Multifaith Chaplaincy?

We are a network of people drawn from a wide range of religious traditions, providing spiritual and pastoral care, and religious advice and guidance for students and staff at Sheffield Hallam.

We also run faith-related activities throughout the year, including prayer, meditation and mindfulness.

Our network consists of two Christian chaplains (Anglican and Roman Catholic) and volunteer faith advisors from a range of faiths, all of whom have been endorsed by their respective faith communities. Our service is available to people of different faiths and none. You do not have to regard yourself as a religious person to get in touch with us.

Our Spaces

At City Campus we have the Multifaith Centre on Level 2 of Owen which includes the chaplaincy office, a quiet room for prayer and relaxation, Muslim prayer rooms and a meeting rooms. Adsetts out-of-hours Quiet Room for prayer and relaxation, Level 4 in the quiet study area.

At Collegiate Campus there is 'The Retreat' - a space for prayer and relaxationon Level 2 of Oaklands, and Muslim prayer rooms on Level 1 of the Oaklands Building.
