The Importance of Leadership

Leadership Expert and Best-Selling author, Dr John Maxwell states that "everything rises and falls on leadership." Leaders can make or break an organisation, advance or destroy a cause, inspire or frustrate a mission, motivate and mobilise, or stagnate and demoralise a movement. Leaders lead the way or lose the way and either way, they take others with them.

The purpose of the MOMENTUM Leadership Program is to identify, train and empower emerging leaders in the core principles for effective Christian leadership in their sphere of influence in fulfilling God's vision for their lives.

The strategy of MOMENTUM Leadership Program is organising seminars and workshops that bringing together experienced leadership practioners and committed, energetig and creative students to explore the critical importance of leadership matters and seek to understand and apply leadership principles so that each student can be holistically equipped to train others and make a difference for God in the world. The world needs them. Their time is now!

MOMENTUM Leadership Program (MLP) will conduct seminars in Sheffield Hallam University as part of the Multifaith Chaplaincy located in the Main Campus Owen Building Level 2 (Howard street, Sheffield, S1 1WB).

These seminars run once a month (in person) from the 24th of October 2023 to 23rd of April 2024. Time is 6:00pm to 7:30pm.

Momentum Leadership Program is anchored on Christian Leadership foundations that are considered essential for young emerging leaders who desire to leave footprints on the seashore of their generation to the glory of God.

MLP is open to all students interested in learning about effective and transformational leadership that society needs in changing times.



THE STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM IS CATEGORISED INTO THREE MODULES:

a. Module 1: SELF LEADERSHIP (Oct - Nov 2023)

The world we now live in is characterised by a complexity in the roles of leaders. There is a unidimensional criterion of success that is portrayed as the standard in a multi-dimensional world. The norm is to put emphasis on the professional life to the neglect of marriage, family and friendship. The inevitable **consequence** is what is known as the "Successful Failure Syndrome". This module is an introduction to leadership and an overview of the differences between secular and Christian perspectives of leadership and management theories. It will also look at how to manage self as a leader for effectiveness by developing a sense of who you are, what you can do and where are going.

There are two sessions in this module, namely:-

Session 1: Introduction to Leadership vs Management.	Date - 24/10/23
Session 2: Self Leadership & Self Awareness	Date - 21/11/23

b. Module 2: SERVANT LEADERSHIP (Jan - Feb 2024)

The second module is about the *skills* of influencing people to work enthusiastically towards goals identified as being for the common good, with character that inspires confidence. Today, servant leadership, as popularised by Robert Greenleaf, is one of the cutting edge leadership models in the secular business arena. The foundation of Biblical servant leadership, however, comes from God as modelled through Jesus Christ.

There are two sessions in the second module, namely:-

Session 3: Style of Influence	Date - 23/01/24
Session 4: Servant Leadership	Date - 20/02/24

c. Module 3: SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP (Mar - April 2024)

The final module is spiritual leadership. The essential difference between the natural leader and the biblical leader is the spiritual nature of Biblical Leadership as a person is empowered by the Holy Spirit. Besides being spiritual by nature and servant by mission, Biblical leaders are transformational because they are called by God to be agents of transformation. The Biblical transformational leader transforms his or her world by being an agent of meaningful change and transforms his or her followers into leaders.

There are two sessions in the second module, namely:-

Session 5: Spiritual Leadership	Date - 19/03/24
Session 6: Transformational Leadership	Date - 16/04/24
