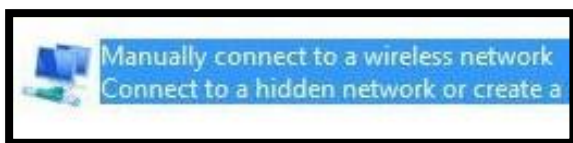
Right click the **Wi-Fi icon** in the system tray and select **Network and Sharing Center**.

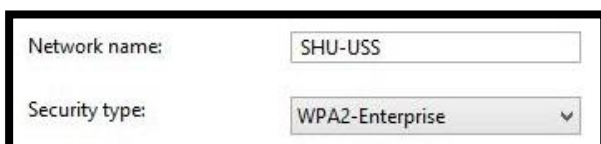
Click **Set up a new connection or network**

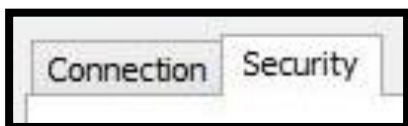

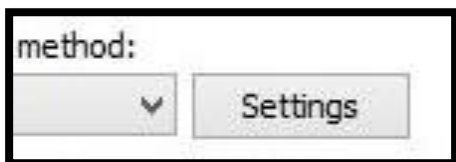

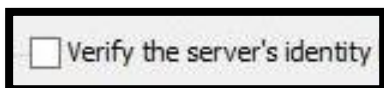

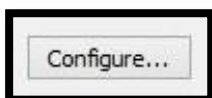

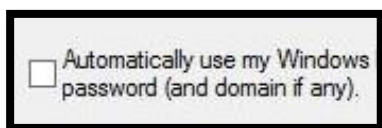

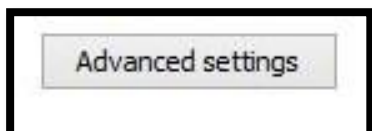
Connecting to SHU Wi-Fi (Windows 8)
