As part of the process we will need to verify <u>one document from Group 1 plus any two from Groups 1, 2a or 2b</u>. At least one document needs to confirm your current address and at least one document needs to confirm your date of birth.

All documents must be originals and we are not permitted to accept photocopies or documents printed from the internet.
