There is no charge for the student's own ticket.

			£0	£36 per year	iCPG JRCALC subscription	Optional			Home Students on clinical placement in receipt of Student Finance England loans will be eligible for placement expenses (i.e. second accommodation and travel, if further than the normal journey to University). More information about the Learning Support Fund can be accessed via Student Finance England website. International students are not eligible to claim placement expenses and these need to be planned for. The SHU placement circuit includes South, West, East and North Yorkshire, North Lincolnshire and Goole, Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire. There are good links by public transport from the Sheffield area but for those placements further afield we usually recommend staying in local Hospital accommodation whilst on placement. Students may wish to subscribe to the iCPG a digital version of the official Joint Royal Colleges Ambulance Liaison Committee (JRCALC) guidelines for ambulance service practitioners. The JRCALC provides clinical guidance for the administration of drugs. The cost of the subscription is £29.99 per year or £2.99 per month.
