Prices for 2024/5 are to be confirmed but in 2022 gowns were £39-£59 depending on level of award, photography costs will be dependent on the student's chosen package and tickets for guests to attend the ceremony were £10 per guest.

If you miss/do not attend three Health Screening Assessment or vaccination appointments, you may be withdrawn from your course, as per the Sheffield Hallam – Student Attendance and Engagement Policy. Further details on this – can be found via the university’s rules and regulations pages.</p> <p>Vaccinations programmes you choose to undertake with your own GP or health provider may be subject to their charges. The University will not reimburse you for these costs.</p> <p>Travel to placement, and in some circumstances additional accommodation costs related to placement, will be incurred.</p> <p>Home Students on clinical placement in receipt of Student Finance England loans will be eligible for placement expenses (i.e. second accommodation and travel, if further than the normal journey to University). More information about the Learning Support Fund can be accessed via Student Finance England website. International students are not eligible to claim placement expenses and these need to be planned for. The SHU placement circuit includes South, West, East and North Yorkshire, North Lincolnshire and Goole, Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire. There are good links by public transport from the Sheffield area but for those placements further afield we usually recommend staying in local Hospital accommodation whilst on placement.</p>
