#### **Session 1: Introductory Slides (1.5 hours)**

Introductions	10 mins
Use <b>PowerPoint 1</b> to:	20 mins
- Explain the overarching aims of the day, go through training ground rules and house-keeping	
- Provide an outline of the Sessions you will be covering in the training	
Form groups of 5-6 people and	20 mins
<ul> <li>Ask them to discuss four key points about what they already know about the trafficking of children into and within the UK</li> </ul>	
- Give themselves a group score between 1 and 10 of their current knowledge of the human trafficking of children	
Feedback to room with the four points and group score	20 mins
Continue to use <b>PowerPoint 1</b> to:	20 mins
- Introduce the Training Pack co-creators – ECPAT UK and the Helena Kennedy Centre for International Justice	
- Highlight the child rights', child-centred and trauma-informed approaches used by ECPAT as foundational	

## Session 2: Overview of International and UK Human Trafficking (1 hour)

Use the first half of <b>PowerPoint 2</b> to explore the international overview of human trafficking	30 mins
- Ask each group to note one part of this presentation that they did not know previously	1
Feedback to room of individual points of new knowledge	30 mins

## Session 3: Dynamics and Forms of the Human Trafficking of Children and Young People in the UK (2.5 – 3 hours)

Use <b>Powerpoint 4</b> to introduce this topic	10 mins
- Provide an outline of the forms to be discussed

- Ask group if they have encountered any children or young people who have experienced labour exploitation	
- Discuss responses	
- Present rest of slides on this topic	
Domestic servitude:	15 mins
- Discuss case of Mo Farah	
- Present rest of slides on this topic	
Child Sexual Exploitation:	15 mins
- Discuss Jay report on Rotherham CSE Inquiry	
- Present slide on CSE	
Child Criminal Exploitation:	15 mins
- Discuss whether practitioners consider this to be mainly male or female	
- Present slides on CCE	
- The Jay Review of Criminally Exploited Children – March 2024 – highlighting huge concerns for children at risk	
Age, nationality and exploitation:	20 mins
- Ask group to look at the slide on the age, nationality and exploitation type and discuss known or surprising	
associations	
Recruitment, control, disclosure and trauma	30 mins
- Present slides	
- Discuss how the patterns of human trafficking shift over time	
Handout the Case Studies PDF Document - Part 1 only	40-60 mins
- Ask participants to work in their groups and provide Sheet 1 and one Case Study per table	
- Nominate a scribe / spokesperson to feedback to the room	
- 15-20 minutes to discuss

- Use printed versions of the CSF-POF PDF Documents with groups to discuss particular aspects of practice	
Introduce the Creating Stable Futures Practice Tool (CSF-PT) (if available)	60 mins
- Provide each group with a copy of Part 2 of the Case Studies and ask them to read this and respond to the	
questions posed in PDF Document of Part 2 of Case Studies	
Introduce the Creating Stable Futures Practice Tool (CSF-PT) (if available)	90 mins
- Provide each group with a copy of the CSF-PT	
- Ask each group to discuss the CSF-PT (Parts 1 and 2 of the case studies can be used when looking at the	
CSF-PT)	
- Each group to provide feedback to room	
Continue to use <b>PowerPoint 5</b> to:	5 mins
- Outline the concluding remarks of the study	
Outline the 'next steps' slides and consider how this might be operationalized in your practice	25 mins
