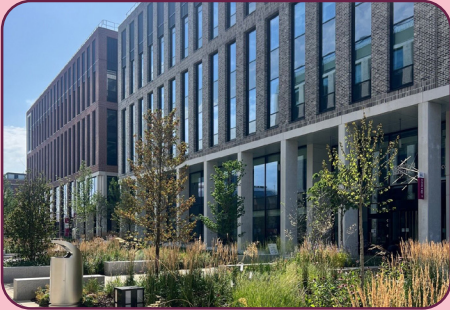

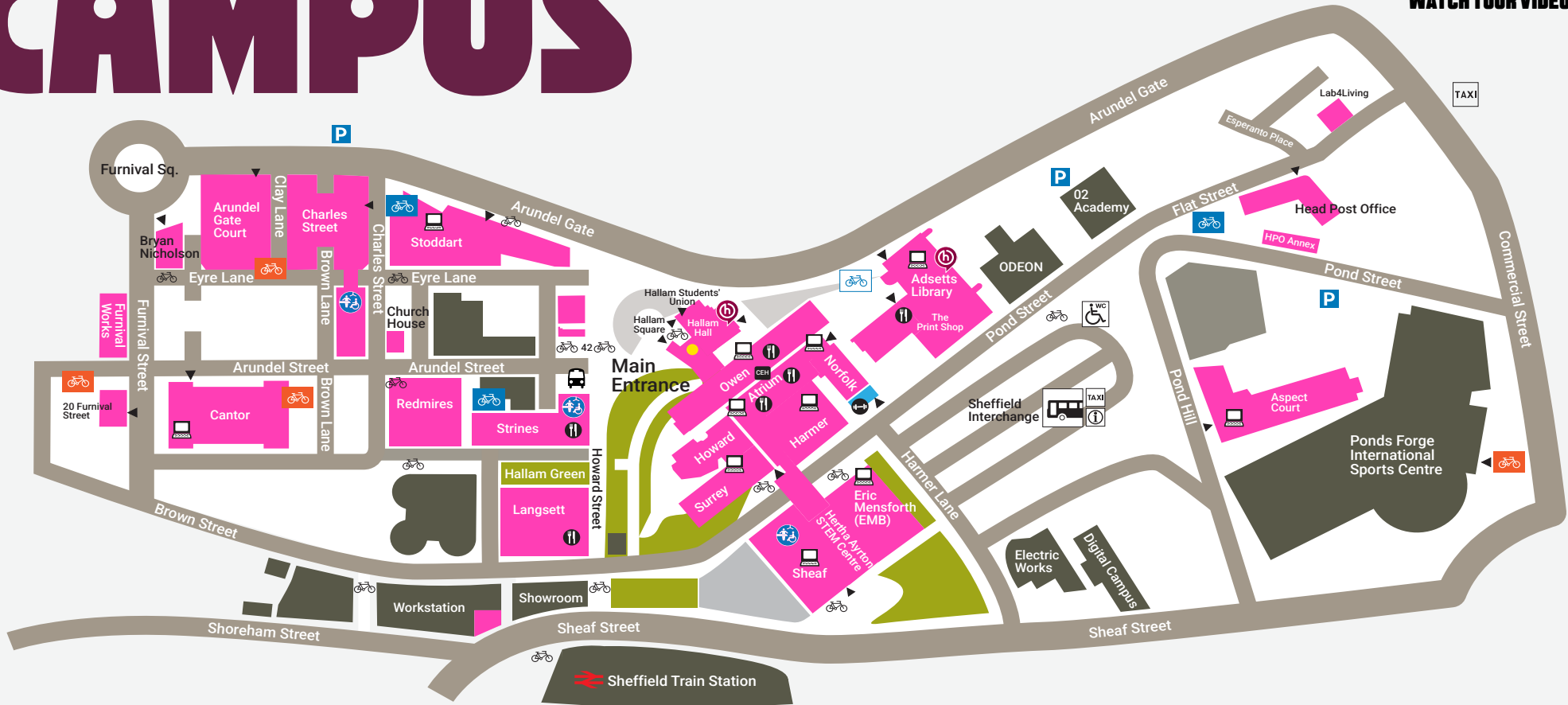

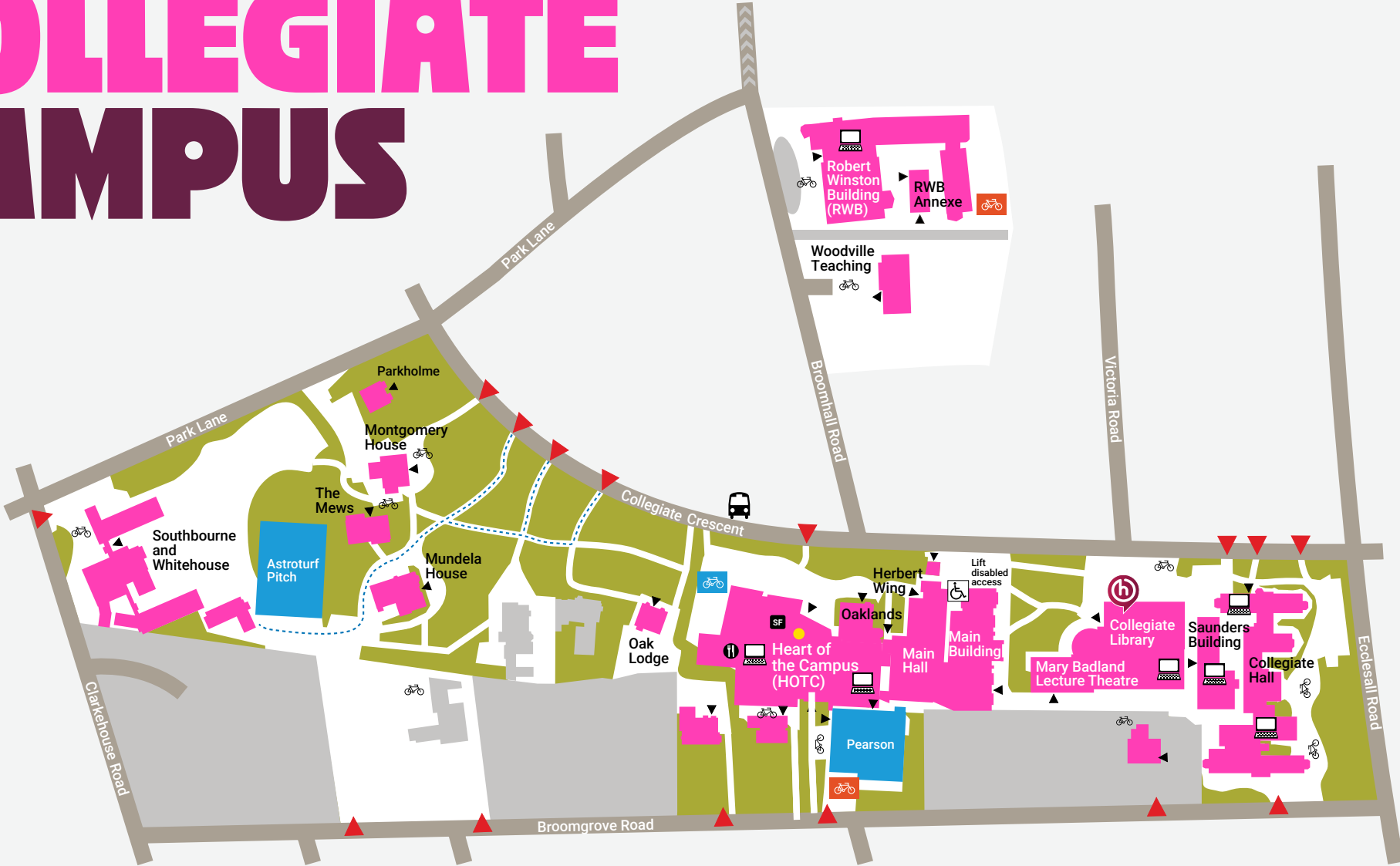

Apply for accommodation

Apply for your student loan

If you haven't applied for a student loan yet, you should apply as soon as possible through Student Finance England.

If you have already applied for a student loan and have changed your original choice of university, you will also need to edit your application. Log into the Student Finance England website for full guidance.
