

FdEng Integrated Engineering - Manufacturing

It is for people currently working in engineering and provides you with the flexibility to work in various roles across your organisation.

You study the underlying principles of engineering before specialising in manufacturing engineering. Business operations and employability are covered throughout the course providing you with the skills and knowledge to build a successful engineering career.

You also complete projects which involve the analysing, designing, prototyping and testing of control and instrumentation systems and components.

After successfully completing this foundation degree, you will study for two more years of part-time to gain a BEng honours degree.
